

**MONROE COUNTY OVERVIEW:**

Between 2013 and 2015 there were a total of 752 crashes reported within Monroe County, Ohio. Around people 190 were injured as result of these crashes which includes 9 fatalities and 41 serious injuries. Overall, the total number of crashes have increased, with 34.2% more crashes in 2015 compared to 2013. That said, reductions can be seen in the number of fatalities and serious injuries resulting from crashes

**KEY FACTS:**

- Between 2013 and 2015 the total number of crashes has increased by 34.2%.
- On average, there 3 fatal crashes per year between 2013 and 2015. That's roughly 1 fatal crash every 4 months.
- Between 2013 and 2015, there were 366 Fixed object crashes (48.7% of total crashes), making this the most common crash type overall and accounts for the largest number of fatalities.
- When they occurred, pedestrian, overturning, and head-on crashes were the most likely to result in an injury.
