

MORGAN COUNTY OVERVIEW:

Between 2013 and 2015 there were a total of 716 crashes reported within Morgan County, Ohio. Around 190 people were injured as result of these crashes which includes 10 fatalities and 52 serious injuries. Overall there has been essentially no change in the total number of crashes, with 0.83% less crashes in 2015 compared to 2013. Even with a very little change in the number of total crashes, an increase can be seen in the number of fatalities but a decrease in serious injuries.

KEY FACTS:

- There's been a 0.83% increase in crashes between 2013 and 2015.
- On average, there 2.7 fatal crashes per year between 2013 and 2015. That's roughly 1 fatal crash every 4.5 months.
- Between 2013 and 2015, there were 294 fixed object crashes (41.1% of total crashes), making this the most common crash type overall and accounts for the largest number of fatalities.
- Though animal related crashes were the second most prevalent crash type overall, they were one of the least likely to result in an injury.
