

PERRY COUNTY OVERVIEW:

Between 2013 and 2015 there were a total of 1,548 crashes reported within Perry County, Ohio. Around 520 people were injured as result of these crashes which includes 11 fatalities and 130 serious injuries. Overall however there has been a decline in the total number of crashes, with 4.58% less crashes in 2015 compared to 2013. However, there has been an increase in the number of fatal and injury crashes.

KEY FACTS:

- There's been a 4.58% reduction in crashes between 2013 and 2015.
- On average, there 3.7 fatal crashes per year between 2013 and 2015. That's roughly 1 fatal crash every 3.25 months.
- Between 2013 and 2015, there were 744 Fixed Object crashes (48.1% of total crashes), making this the most common crash type overall and accounts for the largest number of fatalities.
- Fixed object, angle, overturning, left turn, and head on made up the totality of fatal crashes.
