

**MONROE COUNTY OVERVIEW:**

Between 2013 and 2017 there were a total of 1,392 crashes reported within Monroe County, Ohio. Around 320 people were injured as result of these crashes which includes 15 fatalities and 71 serious injuries. Overall, the total number of crashes have increased, with 29.15% more crashes in 2017 compared to 2013. That said, fatalities have remained stable over this time, and injury crashes have only increased by 16.22%.

**KEY FACTS:**

- Between 2013 and 2017 the total number of crashes has increased by 29.15%.
- On average, there 3 fatal crashes per year between 2013 and 2017. That's roughly 1 fatal crash every 4 months.
- Between 2013 and 2017, there were 676 fixed object crashes (48.6% of total crashes), making this the most common crash type overall and accounts for the largest number of fatalities.
- When they occurred, pedestrian, overturning, and head-on crashes were the most likely to result in an injury.
