

**NOBLE COUNTY OVERVIEW:**

Between 2013 and 2017 there were a total of 947 crashes reported within Noble County, Ohio. Almost 200 people were injured as result of these crashes which includes 14 fatalities and 37 serious injuries. Overall however there has been an increase in the total number of crashes, with 100 more crashes in 2017 compared to 2013. Fatal crashes have decreased over 2016 and 2017.

**KEY FACTS:**

- There's been a 66.67% increase in crashes between 2013 and 2017 however 2017 had 50 more crashes than any other year.
- Between 2013 and 2017, there were 372 fixed object crashes (39.3% of total crashes), making this the most common crash type overall and it accounts for the largest number of fatalities.
- Though animal related crashes were the second most prevalent crash type overall, they were the least likely to result in an injury .
